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1. Overview

Welcome to iQIES! Once you've created your HCQIS Access Roles and Profile (HARP) account, the first thing you will need to do when you log into iQIES is to request a role. However, all organizations must have a Security Official role established to approve all other role requests, and it is recommended that your organization designate at least two security official roles.

The user role tables in the section below will help you determine which role best fits your needs and requirements. Each role's actions and permissions are highlighted to help you make your selection, and each table is organized with the role names in the columns and the permissions in the rows. If necessary, it is possible to request multiple user roles provided each role is in the same user category (ex. CMS, CMS Contractors, Providers, State Agencies, & Vendors). For example, a Security Official may also need to hold an additional General User role.

All users will have access to view their user profile, request roles, and access help content.

2. CMS

2.1 CMS Staff

CMS is responsible for ensuring that all providers/suppliers are in compliance with Federal regulations, which is met through survey, certification, enforcement, and emergency preparedness actions. CMS users have access to nationwide provider, survey, intake and enforcement data.

The following roles are available for CMS Staff under the CMS User Category:

- CMS View Only User
- CMS General User
- CMS Security Official

3. CMS Contractors

CMS Contractors are a Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC) for a private health care insurer that has been awarded a geographic jurisdiction to process Medicare Part A and Part B (A/B) medical claims or Durable Medical Equipment (DME) claims for Medicare Fee-For-Service (FFS) beneficiaries. CMS relies on a network of MACs to serve as the primary operational contact between the Medicare FFS program and the health care providers enrolled in the program. MACs are multi-state, regional contractors responsible for administering both Medicare Part A and Medicare Part B claims.

4. Providers

Providers are organizations, agencies, and facilities that provide healthcare services.

The following roles are available for Providers:

- Assessment Submitter
- Provider Administrator
- Provider Assessment Coordinator
- Provider Assessment Viewer
- Provider Security Official

Note: Assessment Submitter user role can <u>NOT</u> Create, Modify/Inactivate Assessments within the iQIES Assessment User Tool. Provider Assessment Coordinator <u>CAN</u> Create, Modify/Inactivate Assessments within the iQIES Assessment User Tool.

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5. State Agencies

State agencies provide state-level administration and surveying of healthcare providers, along with assessment management, and ICD-10 code management.

The following roles are available for State Agencies:

- State Agency Assessment Coordinator
- State Agency Security Official
- State Agency General User

Note: State Agency General User role <u>CAN</u> add/manage role-specific information within their state(s) and <u>READ-ONLY ACCESS</u> to provider information, surveys, and enforcements outside of their state(s).
